

INTERMEDIATE MX TRACK PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This track is replacing the Mini MX Track located in the southwest corner of the park.

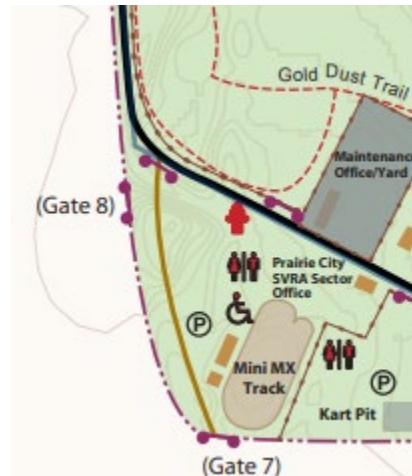


Figure 1. Mini MX Track to be replaced, shown on Prairie City SVRA Map

The Intermediate MX Track will provide an opportunity for those kids who have outgrown the Kid's Track or adults who are not yet ready for the MX Practice Track. This facility will also provide an additional staging area for people using other areas within the park.

A sign will be posted at the entrance to the intermediate MX track staging area. The track direction will be counterclockwise and only 230cc or smaller motorcycles will be allowed. Visitors can ride on the looping, dirt and decomposed granite track spread out over 2 acres.

Bathrooms are located near the staging area and bleachers provide a good view of the track. Ramadas will be added as workload permits after the track has opened. Vegetation swales and trees may be planted to improve aesthetics, habitat value for wildlife, and filter any water generated onsite. A sprinkler system will be installed for staff use to reduce the need for a water truck in between regular maintenance.

The track will be opened to the public and operated the same as the ATV and MX Practice Tracks, and the Kid's Track. The track and staging area may be unavailable on some weekends to allow for use under special event contracts. Call ahead to the kiosk to see if the track is open. We estimate the official track opening this winter - watch social media for updates.
